STARS EU Learning and Teaching Communities

A Learning & Teaching Community (LTC) is a space where education professionals can learn from one another, enhancing their teaching practices, and contributing to pedagogical innovation. They often engage in activities such as workshops, seminars, online discussions, and collaborative development of educational materials.

A handbook on Learning and Teaching Communities in STARS EU has recently been finalized within the framework of the Curriculum Lab. This handbook should be viewed and used as a tool, serving as part of a pathway to promote and enhance LTCs within the STARS EU Alliance.

Its content, particularly the proposed LTC model, is designed to be sufficiently flexible and adaptable, allowing it to accommodate the circumstances and goals of the institutions within the STARS EU Alliance. The handbook also includes a checklist of steps to take in order to create a new LTC or to develop and improve an existing one.



Silesian University organizes Staff Week focusing on STARS EU


