Methodology

Each partner institution accredited in their country to deliver doctoral degrees or offering doctoral programmes has given an overview of existing degrees. The following information is given for each degree :

- Title
- Language
- Possibility to deliver a joint degree
- Duration
- Contact
- Financial aid
- Number
- Connection to STARS EU

Internal consultations were carried out to determine which degrees could be offered jointly. Based on the existing offer, each partner institution has thus indicated the degrees they wish to develop jointly within the STARS EU Alliance in the future. A second consultation round would be necessary to finetune this first list: based on the partner institutions' first proposals, identify the willingness to combine existing degrees and jointly develop new ones.

At this stage, the partner institutions are willing, but not yet in capacity to deliver jointly accredited degrees. Joint supervision and cotutelles will be the first step towards codesigning and delivering joint degrees.

The list below should be considered as a preliminary step, to be further discussed in the TIGs and finetuned with Challenge lab and Regional transition accelerator. Regarding the wide range of existing degrees within the partner institutions, opportunities for developing joint degrees will be further investigated in the near future.
